The researcher conducted a survey of final year students of BTech and MBA in various colleges on their inclination towards starting their own business. A number of students expressed their intention to start own business within 5 years of graduation after gaining work experience. As per the study, BTech students are more inclined to become Entrepreneurs than MBA students. Attitude to take risk and Confidence came out as major factors that influence the students to start their ventures, whereas parental support, family background, Role Models, Institutional support by way of building awareness, skill building ,mentoring etc are the other supporting factors. The study also made a number of recommendations to promote and encourage entrepreneurship in Higher Educational Institutions. After the successful viva voce, Ms Satya Lakshmi was declared eligible for the award of PhD subject to approval by the Academic Council of the University.


