It is my great pleasure to present the Eighth Annual Report of the Institute of Chartered Financial Analysts of India University, Jharkhand for the Year 2018-19.

During the year, the University updated its Curricula for all of its programs, in line with the rapidly changing developments in Technology and Society so that the graduating students will be future-ready. During 2018-19, the University introduced BBA-LL.B (Honours) and LL.B programs, on receipt of approval from Bar Council of India.

The University has been focusing on Research, besides imparting Quality Education. Its Faculty Members and PhD Scholars have been contributing new knowledge, by way of publication of papers / articles in leading journals (in India and abroad) and also in Conferences. Besides, its PhD Scholars have been pursuing Management Research in areas, relevant to the Industry and the Society, in particular, to the State of Jharkhand.

In order to “Groom its Students into Competent Professionals, with Character and Values”, the University introduced a course on “Health and Happiness” in all of its programs. The University continues to serve the Society, by way of a number of Societal Outreach Initiatives like Blood Donation Camps and Services to the under-privileged sections of the Society. In line with the guidelines from Ministry of HRD, the University launched Swachh Bharat Summer Internships 2018 in the neighbouring Simalia Village, wherein 53 students participated. The University also set up a Legal Aid Clinic to build legal awareness and provide free legal services to the poor and needy people in the neighbourhood.

The University was ranked 8th and 9th among the Private Universities in East Zone of India as per Digital Learning Magazine Universities Rankings 2019 and the Week-Hansa Research Survey 2019, respectively.

Necessary infrastructure is in place to meet the requirements of the programs. The academic progress of the University has been satisfactory during the year under review. Students that graduated from the University in 2019 secured good campus placements in reputed companies. Besides, some students of the University have become Entrepreneurs.

Regular meetings of the University authorities, viz., Board of Governors, Board of Management, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Boards of Study, are being conducted, as per the provisions of the Act and the Statutes.

We are grateful to the Government of Jharkhand for their encouragement and support. Its continued support will go a long way, in continuing our services as a Quality Focused University in the State.

The enclosed report gives details of activities of the University for the year 2018-19.

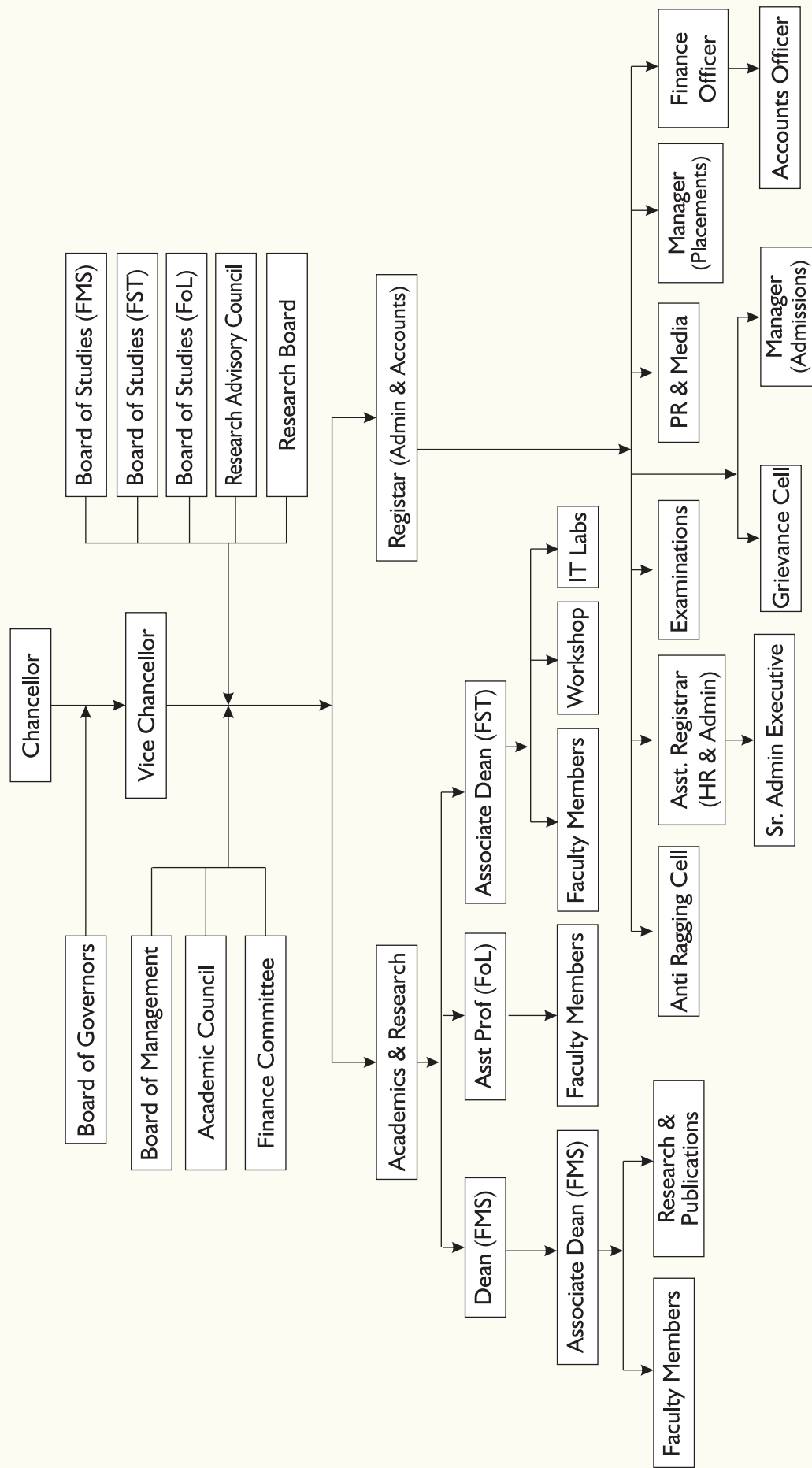

The Ph.D. Program (Part time) in Mgmt: The Part time Ph.D. Program in Management is designed for working corporate executives and faculty members, to expose them to develop in-depth research skills and gain in-depth understanding of the subject, which will help them to improve their ability for teaching, research and in their own profession.

Duration of the Program: This program is normally for a period of four years, wherein the scholar is required to complete the course work, prepare and defend thesis. Maximum duration of the program is seven years. However, in exceptional cases, this can be extended further, subject to approval.

Eligibility: The applicant should meet the following eligibility requirements for admission:

Qualification: Post-Graduation (minimum 2 years duration) or equivalent, in management or allied subjects (like Economics, Commerce, Public Administration, Social Sciences, etc.), with at least 55% marks or equivalent CGPA or M.Phil Degree in the concerned subject or allied subject.

Experience: Minimum 3 years in industry/banking / financial services / government / academics etc.

Program Structure: The Program consists of the following phases:

Phase I - Course Work: Comprises two theory subjects, Research Methods and Elective, covering broadly the field of specialization, chosen by the scholar.

Phase II – Registration for Ph.D: Scholars, who successfully complete the coursework, can register for the Ph.D program.

Phase III – Preparation of Research Proposal: The scholar will prepare the research proposal under the guidance of the Research Supervisor and the same will be presented in a Seminar for approval.

Phase IV – Data Collection / Survey: After approval of the proposal, the scholar will collect the needed data and take up the survey. The scholar is expected to present a Seminar on "Progress of Research".

Phase V - Pre-Submission Thesis Seminar: This Seminar is presented by the scholar, whose Ph.D thesis is ready for submission.

Phase VI - Report on Progress of Research: The scholar works under the guidance of a Research Supervisor and is required to submit at the end of every semester, a report on Progress of Research and also present the same in a seminar.

Phase VII - Submission of Ph.D Thesis and Viva Voce

Award of Degree: Successful scholars will receive the Ph.D degree from the University, subject to University regulations.

Faculty of Management Studies (FMS)

The MBA Program: The MBA Program of the University prepares the students with the knowledge, skills and strategic perspectives essential to business leadership and a managerial career in the world. The MBA Program is designed to provide both a portfolio of strong functional skills and the ability to apply, adapt and integrate those skills in different management settings.

Duration: Two years

Eligibility: Graduation in any discipline with 45% and above aggregate marks.

Program Structure: The Program covers 28 courses apart from soft skills and management thesis spread over 4 semesters in 2 years. Students are also required to undergo a summer internship program for 10 weeks.

Electives: The students are encouraged to choose eight courses from eight elective streams namely, Marketing, HRM, Finance, Banking, Investments, Insurance, Accounting and IT & Systems. Students will have the flexibility in choosing more than one course from these elective streams. Students will also have the facility for dual specialization. Elective courses will be offered subject to a minimum number of students enrolling for a particular elective course.

Award of Degree: Successful students will receive the MBA degree from the University, subject to University regulations.

MBA Program for Working Professionals: In order to cater to the needs of working professionals aspiring to pursue MBA, this program is being offered from 2013-14 academic year. Duration and program structure for this program are the same as for the regular MBA Program, except that the regular classes are held in the evening.

Eligibility: Graduation in any discipline with 45% and above aggregate marks and a minimum of 2 years of work experience

Award of Degree: Successful students will receive the MBA degree from the University, subject to University regulations. Students who have successfully completed first two semesters of the MBA Program and are unable to pursue the third semester will be awarded Diploma in Business Administration. They will be allowed to register for 3rd semester of subsequent batch, within 3 years, by paying re-admission fee and semester fee applicable for that batch of students and complete the MBA Program. MBA Program will be awarded to the successful students, on return of the Diploma that was awarded.

The BBA Program: The Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) Program is a 3 year full-time program offered by the University with a view to impart in-depth knowledge and broad understanding of the basics of Management. The BBA Program focuses on various areas of Management and prepares students for a Professional career in Management and also equips them to pursue MBA Program in due course.

Duration: Three Years.

Eligibility: Pass in 10+2 with aggregate 40% and above (any discipline).

Program Structure: The BBA Program consists of 36 courses covered in six semesters spread over three years. Students are also required to do Summer

Internship after completion of Year I and II respectively.

Elective Streams: During the 5th and 6th semester, students are exposed to elective courses in their respective fields of specialization. These elective courses provide an understanding of the specialized focus fields.

Award of Degree: Students who successfully complete the BBA Program will be awarded the 'Bachelor of Business Administration' Degree by the University.

The B.Com (Hons) Program: The Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com (Hons)) Program is a 3-year campus based program offered by the University with a view to impart in-depth knowledge and broad understanding of accounting and financial management. The curriculum of B.Com (Hons.) program provides carefully selected subject combination of accountancy, economics, management and decision science, banking & insurance and commercial law. The program prepares the students with the knowledge, skills and attitude to meet the challenges of the modern day business organizations and also equips them to pursue MCom or MBA degree program and other professional courses further or a career in Banking / Financial Services / Insurance / Corporates.

Duration: Three Years.

Eligibility: Pass in 10+2 in any discipline inclusive of Commerce with 40% and above aggregate marks; Students awaiting results can also apply.

Award of Degree: Students who successfully complete the B.Com (Hons.) Program will be awarded the 'Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) degree by the University, subject to the University Regulations.

The BA (Hons.) in Journalism & Mass Communication: The Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Journalism and Mass Communication is a three year, six semester, full-time, campus-based program, with a view to impart the students an in-depth academic base and hands-on skills in Journalism and Mass Communications so that they can build a career in fields like Journalism, Advertising, Media Management, Event Management, Public Relations etc.

Duration: Three Years.

Eligibility: Pass in 10+2 in any discipline with 40% and above aggregate marks. Students awaiting results also can apply.

Award of Degree: Successful students will receive the Bachelor of Arts (Honours) Degree in Journalism and Mass Communication, subject to University Regulations.

Faculty of Science and Technology

The B.Tech Program: The B.Tech. Program is a four-year, eight-semester, full-time, campus-based program. The Program provides cutting edge education to equip students with comprehensive and critical understanding in various branches of engineering.

The following branches of engineering are offered:

- a. Computer Science & Engineering
- b. Mechanical Engineering
- c. Mining Engineering

Eligibility: The eligibility criteria for admission into the B.Tech Program is 50% aggregate and above in 12th Class examinations or its equivalent with pass in each of the Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English subjects. The applicant should fulfill the minimum age requirements as prescribed by the respective board through which the applicant has appeared for the qualifying examination. Students who pass 3 year Diploma program in respective branch of Engineering will be eligible for admission into second year of B.Tech program by Lateral Entry.

Award of Degree: On successful completion of the Program, students will be awarded B.Tech Degree by the University, subject to University regulations.

The BCA Program: The program provides a sound academic base in computer skills and IT applications, from which an advanced career in computer applications can be developed. The students get a good conceptual grounding in computer usage and its practical business applications. The BCA Program focuses on various areas of IT and prepares students for a career in the field of Information Technology and also equips them to pursue MCA program in due course.

Eligibility: Pass in 10+2/Intermediate with aggregate 40% and above in any discipline.

Duration: Three years

During the 5th semester, students are exposed to elective courses in their respective field of specialization. These elective courses provide an understanding of the specialized focus fields.

Award of Degree: Students who successfully complete the BCA Program will be awarded the 'Bachelor of Computer Applications' degree by the University, subject to University regulations.

The MCA Program: The Master of Computer Applications (MCA) is a three year, six semester, full-time, campus-based program, with a view to impart the students an in-depth academic base in IT and hands-on skills in computer applications so that they can build an advanced career in IT. The program covers cutting-edge technology inputs as well as provides IT skills in programming and application development, as per industry requirements. Students that passed BCA or BSc (IT or Computer Science) Degree, with Mathematics as a subject at 10+2 level or Degree level are eligible for Lateral Entry and join second year (3rd semester) of the program.

Duration: Three years (Two years for Lateral Entry)

Eligibility: For MCA: Graduation (10+2+3 or 10+2+4) in any discipline, with 40% and above aggregate marks.

For MCA (Lateral Entry): Pass in BCA or BSc (IT or Computer Science) Degree (with Mathematics as a subject at 10+2 level or Degree level) with 40% and above aggregate marks.

Award of Degree: Successful students will receive the MCA degree from the University, subject to University Regulations.

The Diploma in Technology Program: The Diploma in Technology Program is a three-year, six-semester, full-time, campus-based program. The Program provides cutting edge education to equip the students with comprehensive and critical understanding in Engineering Discipline. The program prepares the students for Careers in Engineering and also equips them to pursue B.Tech in the respective branch of Engineering through lateral entry into second year (3rd semester) of B.Tech program.

Duration: Three years

Eligibility: Pass in 10th Class with 50% aggregate with pass in each of the Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry. The applicant should fulfill the minimum age requirements as prescribed by the respective board through which the applicant has appeared for the qualifying examination.

Award of Degree: On successful completion of the Diploma in Technology Program, students will be awarded Diploma in Technology by the ICFAI University, Jharkhand, subject to University Regulations.

The following branches of engineering are offered:

- a. Computer Science & Engineering
- b. Mechanical Engineering
- c. Mining Engineering

Faculty of Law

The BBA-LL.B (Hons) Program: The BBA-LL.B (Honours) is a five-year, ten-semester, full-time, campus-based program. The Program offers a thorough and deep knowledge of the law courses to the students. The program includes law and management courses, which consist of 4 Clinical, 6 Electives, 8 Honours Courses and 5 Legal Internships.

Eligibility: Pass in 10+2 or equivalent with 45% and above aggregate marks in any discipline (best of the 5 subjects including English). Students awaiting results may also apply.

Duration: Five years

Award of Degree: On successful completion of the Program, students will be awarded BBA-LL.B (Honours) degree by the University, subject to University regulations.

The LL.B Program: The LL.B is a three-year, six-semester, full-time, campus-based program. The Program is contemporary and rigorous with innovatively designed curriculum. It consists of 6 semesters which includes Clinical Courses and Legal Internships.

Eligibility: Pass with 45% and above aggregate marks in Graduation or equivalent (in any discipline). Students awaiting final Year examination results are also eligible for admission. Applicants should not be more than 30 years of age as on the day of commencement of the Semester I.

Duration: Three years

Award of Degree: On successful completion of the Program, students will be awarded the LL.B degree by the University, subject to University regulations.

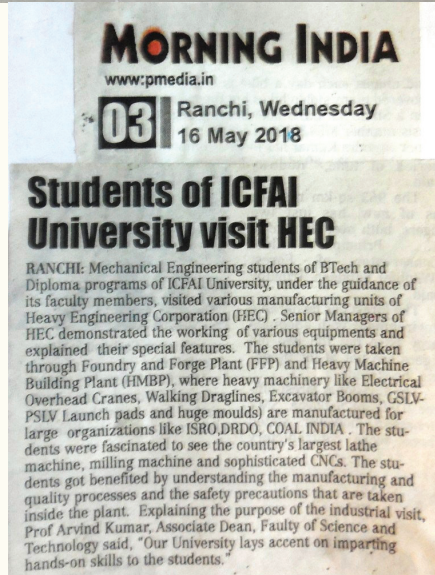
